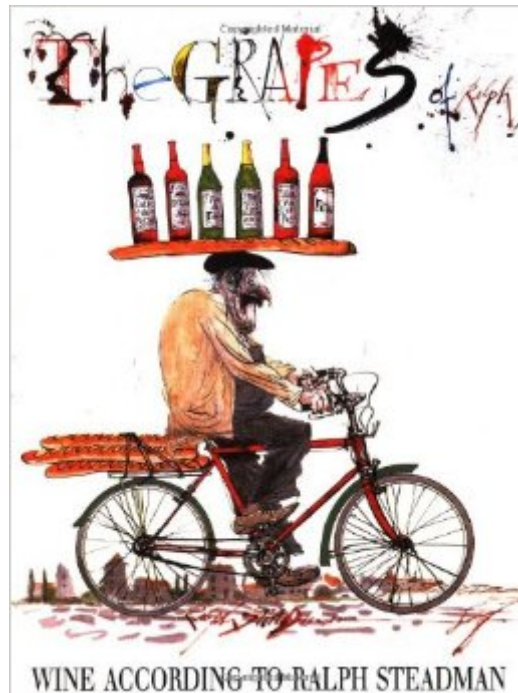

This is essentially a travel journal, and it's a very good one. We join Ralph Steadman on his journey around the world to different countries, looking for wine. He walks on the dirt track leading to vineyards, watches grape being crushed and savors them in a glass. The writeup is excellent and detailed, looking into the life of people in the business of making wine. The wonderful illustrations are a bonus, and complementary.
